## What is ACPL Connect?

---

**ACPL Connect** is the result of **Alamance County Public Libraries** working together with **Alamance County schools** to provide students with easily accessible information and educational resources.

Students no longer need library cards. Instead, students can use their **school ID** to access library services.

*The default PIN is the last 4 digits of the student ID number.*
